RE: Schmooze Communications and PBXact

To Whom It May Concern:

Last year our school district built a new elementary school. We looked at several phone systems for the new building. After evaluating the various systems based on cost, ease of use, ease of management, and features, we chose PBXact. The reasonable price of a PBXact solution allowed us to place phones in every classroom in the building, which is something we wouldn't have been able to do with some of the other options.

Deployment of the system was extremely easy. The PBX came preconfigured. All I had to do was connect it to the network and activate the phones. The Magic Button speech recognition allowed our teachers to start using the system with only a 15 minute introduction. Personally, the Magic Button is one of my favorite features. I am able to make calls by saying a name rather than looking up someone's number.

Ease of management has been an area where PBXact has been outstanding. The management interface makes configuration changes simple and is so easy to understand that I rarely encounter something I can't handle. The few times I have had questions, the support team at Schmooze has been very helpful.

Our initial deployment of PBXact has been so successful that we have already deployed it to two additional buildings, with plans for two more buildings this summer. We are also going to connect two of our legacy PBXs to PBXact. Once those changes are complete, all calls between district buildings will flow across our WAN and through our PBXact system. This setup will allow us to cancel 19 analog phone lines and save us over \$800 per month in local phone charges.

I would recommend PBXact to any school or business looking for an affordable, easy to use and manage phone system.
